City Council to make announcement concerning future of Ogden City water and sewer systems

OGDEN, UTAH (April 16, 2007) — During the April 24, 2007 Ogden City Council meeting, the Council will make an announcement concerning the upcoming decisions, policies and processes which the Council will address in the coming months relative to Ogden's water and sewer systems.

This impending announcement is the direct result of Council members expressing a desire to be proactive in making sure that City culinary water, storm sewer, and sanitary sewer systems are safe and will provide the residents of Ogden with quality water resources and services.

Because the city's water needs are increasing and the infrastructure continues to get older, the Council will announce plans concerning its desire to stay up-to-date on the most current water and sewer-related information that will affect Ogden.

According to The Utah Division of Water Resources "approximately 70 percent of Utah's developed water is used in agriculture. As the state's population grows, water is slowly being converted from watering fields to supplying cities and towns."
