- Welcome and Call to Order – Scott Patria
  - Approval of January minutes

- First Friday Art Stroll - Update – All
  - The art stroll had more foot traffic than usual due to the Yeti Bash at Union Station
  - There was a constant flow of people for Ogden Uncon who had a booth at the bash
  - Gallery 25, Rainy Day Emporium & Zucca downstairs all had steady foot traffic
  - Van Sessions had a good turn out and it helped that it started after the Yeti Bash
  - People were disappointed that the galleries at Union Station were closed
- Arts on the Town - Lorie Buckley
  - The date is April 25, 2019 at The Monarch
  - Lorie said that she would like the committees help in choosing two grantees that could speak at the event
  - She is looking for someone to play music and is thinking about having food from Zucca
  - There will be a slideshow of pictures on display for everyone to look at
- Public Art/Creative District – Lorie Buckley
  - The projects that were voted on are still in process We are waiting on the ordinance change to proceed forward

- The call for artist is out for everyone to share and apply to The projects are the boxes and the poster contest for Spike 150
  - Lorie said they have found a grant writer to help find money, Kate Badoe To create projects, they will use Union Creative to help in this area

  - The arts grants are due March 15 It was discussed if the committee would like to receive the grants as they come in or one at a time
  - It was decided that a meeting will be setup before March 15 with the subcommittee to go over questions about the grants received

  - Ogden Symphony is rebranding themselves bringing new changes this year They are starting off by having a ribbon cutting ceremony on March 20 at 3 30 p m at the Art Center
  - They are working with a company who has sent out surveys to see what would be best for improvements It is a great way to kick off their 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary
  - On Friday the Diversity Commission will have interviews with six candidates for their open positions
  - They are also working with Ogden CAN to help bring awareness about the poverty in Ogden
  - A resource fair is in the works to help people between the ages 16-21 with jobs There seems to be a gap of jobs for this age group


- The Argo House will do a test class of life drawing, if all goes well a series of classes will start
