 - a. Ogden City needs to have an Enterprise agreement.
2. Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this?
(like, from India or Canada)
 - a. Company must be able to provide Azure Gov as opposed to Azure Enterprise Cloud.
3. Whether we need to come over for meetings?
 - a. No, not required.
4. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA?
(like, from India or Canada)
 - a. No, cannot perform tasks outside of USA.
