## Ogden's Holiday Season Begins November 25

Ogden's holiday season begins the Saturday after Thanksgiving with the **Holiday Electric Light Parade**. Starting at 5:30 p.m., elaborate floats and fantastic performers will fill Washington Boulevard from 22nd Street to 26th Street.

Santa will be featured on the last float of the parade to ceremoniously flip the switch that illuminates all of Christmas Village when the parade stops at the Municipal Gardens.

The opening ceremony begins approximately at 6:30 p.m. with parade floats on display along 25th Street through the night, live entertainment featured at the amphitheater, and a spectacular fireworks show.

**After this kick-off celebration, Christmas Village will set Ogden's downtown**

**area aglow with magnificent displays and holiday lights until January 1, 2018.** Cottages modeled after Santa's village at the North Pole turn Ogden's downtown Municipal Gardens into a winter wonderland. The lights are on at Christmas Village from 5:00 p.m. to midnight every night and admission is free.

## Fire Escape Planning is Important

**Once a fire alarm sounds, you may only have one or two minutes to escape safely.** Fire can spread rapidly through your home, so follow these steps to make sure your household is able to get out with advance warning from smoke alarms and advance planning.

- 1. Install smoke alarms on every level of the home.** This includes one inside every sleeping room and outside each separate sleeping area.
- 2. Smoke alarms should be interconnected.** When one sounds, they all sound.
- 3. Pull together everyone in your household and make a plan.** Walk through your home and inspect all possible exits and escape routes. Households with children should consider drawing a floor plan of your home. Mark the location of each smoke alarm and two ways out of each room, including windows and doors.
