**ALCOHOL PERMIT FOR THE MTC LEARNING PARK
1750 MONROE BLVD.**

_____ is hereby given under authority of Section 12.28.084 Alcohol Permits at MTC Learning Park, permission to possess and consume alcoholic beverages at their _____ on _____ 20_____ from _____ to _____.

This alcohol permit is issued with compliance with the following Ordinance 94-22, 5-24-1994 and Parks Divisions rules and regulations.

- 1. The permittee shall provide a reasonable fee for fifty dollars, non-refundable to cover potential damage to property and to guarantee compliance with all rules and regulations.**
- 2. Alcohol consumption will be confined to the area east of the parking lot by the Mountain Fuel Station and not more than five feet from the main conference pavilion and no further than 20 feet from the parkway trail inside the MTC Park boundaries. Alcohol is not permitted in the parking lot areas within these boundaries nor is it allowed anywhere on the parkway trail.**
- 3. Glass bottles are not permitted in the Park.**

12.28.084. Alcohol Permits at MTC Learning Park:

12.28.084A. Persons, firms or corporations who reserve the MTC Learning Park for private parties, weddings, business meetings, or other similar functions may apply for an alcohol permit which will allow participants to possess and consume alcohol during such function. The Public Services Director in accordance with departmental rules and regulations and only under the following conditions may issue such alcohol permits:

12.28.084A1. No persons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be allowed to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage.

12.28.084A2. The permittee shall provide licensed private security to insure that rules and regulations regarding alcohol possession and consumption are followed.

12.28.084A3. The permittee shall provide a reasonable deposit to cover potential damage to property and to guarantee compliance with all rules and regulations.

12.28.084A4. An alcohol permit fee shall be paid as provided in 4.20.

12.28.084A5. The permit shall designate the specific areas allowed for alcohol possession and consumption, which shall be distinct from the general parkway area and no consumption shall be allowed outside of the area or in the parking lot area.

12.28.084A6. No sales of alcohol shall be permitted.

12.28.084A7. Food must be available as part of the function.

12.28.084A8. No participants shall be allowed to become inebriated.

12.28.084A9. Alcohol permits shall be allowed for private functions only, and shall not be allowed if open to the general public.

12.28.084B. The Public Service Department shall notify the Police Department, at least seven (7) days in advance of the function, of the issuance of any alcohol permit, the designated areas for the permit and the date and times for which the permit is valid. The alcohol permit shall be posted as provided in departmental rules and regulations during any time in which the possession and consumption of alcohol is permitted.

12.28.084C. An alcohol permit is a revocable privilege and if any police officer or employee of the Public Ways and Parks Department observes violations of the permit requirements, the officer or employee may immediately rescind the permit, and order the immediate cessation of alcohol consumption and the removal of all alcoholic beverages from the park. No permit shall be issued to any person or organization if violations of the provisions of this Chapter or applicable rules and regulations have occurred during previous functions. (Ord. 94-22, 5-24-1994).

This permit is a revocable privilege. If any of these rules and regulations are not fully enforced, the permit will be immediately rescinded by the Ogden City Police Department and or Public Ways and Parks Department Employee citing the violations and no future permits shall be issued to the permittee for alcohol consumption.
