7. Home to a tailoring company, and a soft drink store, this 1911 building was a prominent hotel along 25<sup>th</sup> Street as well.

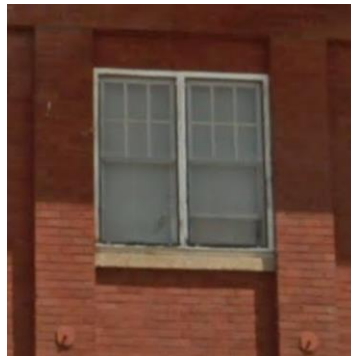
